Cancellations for each separately purchased space at a Spring Event must be received and confirmed by the Palisade Chamber of Commerce 72 hours before the event to receive a refund. Refunds will **NOT** be given for the \$75.00 package after 11a.m. on March 25, 2010. There are NO inclement weather refunds. The Spring Events go rain or shine.

Contact the Town of Palisade at 970-464-5602.
- The Town of Palisade and Palisade Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for theft or damages to property belonging to persons participating in the events.
- Cancellations for each separately purchased space at a Spring Event must be received and confirmed by the Palisade Chamber of Commerce 72 hours before the event to receive a refund. Refunds will **NOT** be given for the \$75.00 package after 11a.m. on March 25, 2010. There are NO inclement weather refunds. The Spring Events go rain or shine.
